- Friday 9th Feb: Twilight meet Modified Program 1a.
- Saturday 10th: Region Track and Field Day 1.

A couple of reminders for the start of the season:

- When a team is nominated for set up or pack up duty on a Saturday morning throughout the season it is the responsibility of the families within that team to be at Masons Lane at 7:30am to assist with the set up so that program commences on time and all athletes are on track for an 8:30am start time. This is the obligation of all families.
- All awards given on competition day PB Stars,

- training awards, Centre Records etc and athlete warm up's will be completed prior to 8:30am. So, please ensure that you arrive at Mason's Lane before 8:15am to be a part of this.
- All parent volunteers are required to make their way out to their nominated event prior to 8:30am. Chief Marshall can collect their folders and radio from the Announcer's desk.
- Only one call will be made for parent assistance for the field events in the circumstances where there are not enough volunteers at these events at the time of marshalling the athletes. Little Athletes is a volunteer based sport and it only runs with the support of parent volunteers each and every week.
- There are to be NO ball games played near the Triple Jump/Long Jump pits. If athletes are too busy playing ball games and miss the call for their event. That event will be cancelled.
- Lastly, in the age groups where chaperones don't escort the athletes to their track and field events (Under 9 and up) it is the responsibility of the athlete, not the other athletes in the age group to get themselves to their events. So, please listen to all the calls that are made and be at your events on time.

The Maryborough Open day is coming up soon, which is a fantastic event that BMLAC have been a part of for many years. If your child wishes to participate in this open day, please register via Results HQ. If there are any other open days that your family might be interested in attending, please let the Committee know and we will open the portal for you to register.
